

SAVIR Authorship Guidelines

Manuscripts are a likely by-product of SAVIR activities. The following guidelines will outline SAVIR policies for authorship on manuscripts that arise out of SAVIR activities.

1. If the manuscript is commissioned on behalf of SAVIR, then the authorship must identify in the author line "on behalf of SAVIR." The committee can be specifically designated if approved by the Board. SAVIR can commission manuscripts through the Board or a SAVIR Committee. Manuscripts commissioned by SAVIR need to be approved by the Executive Committee.
2. If the paper arises out of a group of SAVIR members based on SAVIR committee or other activities, SAVIR should be acknowledged as such:

"The authors acknowledge the Society for Advancement of Violence and Injury Research and its role in initiating this manuscript."

Authorship is decided by the first author and should follow established authorship principles, including substantial contributions to the development of the manuscript by all named authors.
